



100 Years Serving The Residents of Ionia County

The Ionia County Road Commission maintains 1,381 miles of road and 66 bridges located in Ionia County

- 390 Miles are the County's primary road system.
• 682 Miles are the County's local road system.
• 209 Lane miles are state trunk line roads maintained under contract with the Michigan Department of Transportation.
• Mileages under these systems are certified under Act 51 of the Public Act of 1951, as amended.
• Funds for maintenance of public roads in the state of Michigan come from fuel taxes and vehicle registration fees deposited in the Michigan Transportation Fund, not from property taxes or sales taxes.
